There is a right vocal cord mass (red arrow) in this patient with hoarseness. Remember, if a patient presents with hoarseness, think about intrinsic laryngeal abnormalities and lesions involving the vagus/recurrent laryngeal nerves. For the answer image below, I purposely did not choose the image that shows the greatest extent of the mass because the mass distorts the anatomy so severely. On the image below, you can see the mass nicely, but can still appreciate some normal anatomy.
